2026 "SAINT-ANTOINE-EBMT ACHIEVEMENT/YOUNG-LEADER AWARD

The France Saint-Antoine-EBMT Achievement/Young Leader Award honors European / French or Chinese individuals or institutions for their contributions to the development of hematology particularly (but not exclusively) in the field of stem cell transplantation and cell therapy.

Call for applications for the France "SAINT-ANTOINE-EBMT ACHIEVEMENT/ YOUNG-LEADER AWARD 2026" is posted in the website of SFGM-TC. Candidates are asked to prepare a complete document (see Article 3) and send to: veronique.skalli@sat.aphp.fr before the midnight of March 1 2026.

SAINT-ANTOINE-EBMT ACHIEVEMENT AND YOUNG-LEADER AWARDS

Article 1

The Fondation de France has set up awards entitled "Saint-Antoine-EBMT Achievement Award" and "Saint-Antoine-EBMT Young Leader Award" to commend outstanding doctors, scholars, researchers and young talents in the field of Hematology across China and France, and as a platform to further promote the innovation of Franco-Chinese cooperation in Hematology. The awards are supported by the International Transplant Centre in France (EBMT Paris Office), the French Society of Hematology, the SFGM-TC and the Hematology Department of the Saint-Antoine Hospital, as well as the Boxiao Foundation.

Article 2

The awards honor French or Chinese individuals or institutions for their contributions to the development of hematology particularly (but not exclusively) in the field of stem cell transplantation and cell therapy.

The "Saint-Antoine-EBMT Achievement Award / Young Leader Award" will be awarded annually to up to two outstanding personnel or teams from China or France.

Article 3

Candidates should submit their CV with a list of publications and a summary of work plans or descriptions of the work they have undertaken for the scientific cooperation described in Article 1. The document submitted (exclude the CV) will not be exceeded four A4 pages (single-spaced, 12 font).

Article 4

The jury is composed of scientists from the EBMT, the French Society of Hematology and the Hematology Department of the Saint-Antoine Hospital, as well as representatives from the financial supporters. As required during the review of documents, the jury may seek external

experts for their opinions.

Article 5

The application for the "Saint-Antoine-EBMT Achievement / Young-Leader Award" is open from January 1st to March 1st each year.

Article 6

The laureates of the awards are announced every year after the annual meeting of the EBMT and/or if applicable during the "China-France Symposium In Hematology--Annual Summit" which may follow EBMT annual congress during the same year.

Article 7

The "Saint-Antoine-EBMT Achievement / Young-Leader Award" is presented annually at the "China-France Symposium In Hematology Annual Summit" organized by the International Transplant Centre in France (EBMT Paris Office), the French Society of Hematology, the SFGM-TC, the Saint-Antoine Hospital and the Chinese Medical Doctor Association. Such a scientific event will be held in France or in China.

Article 8

The "Saint-Antoine-EBMT Achievement / Young-Leader Award" includes a certificate, an amount of 10,000 euros and a medal for "Saint-Antoine-EBMT Achievement Award" or an amount of 5,000 euros for "Saint-Antoine-EBMT Young-Leader Award".

Laureates and representatives of their countries, representatives of the EBMT and the evaluation committee would be invited to attend the award ceremony.
